The Fourth Regional Plan provided specific recommendations to promote inclusive growth that would bring shared prosperity, equity, improved health, and sustainability for the region.

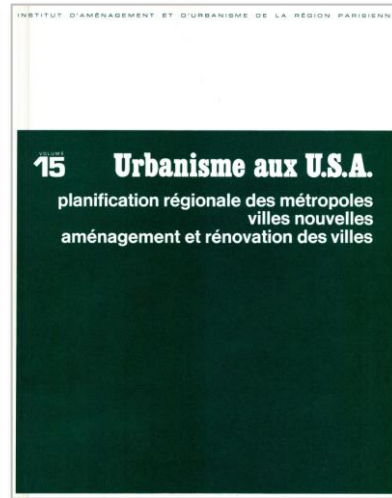
