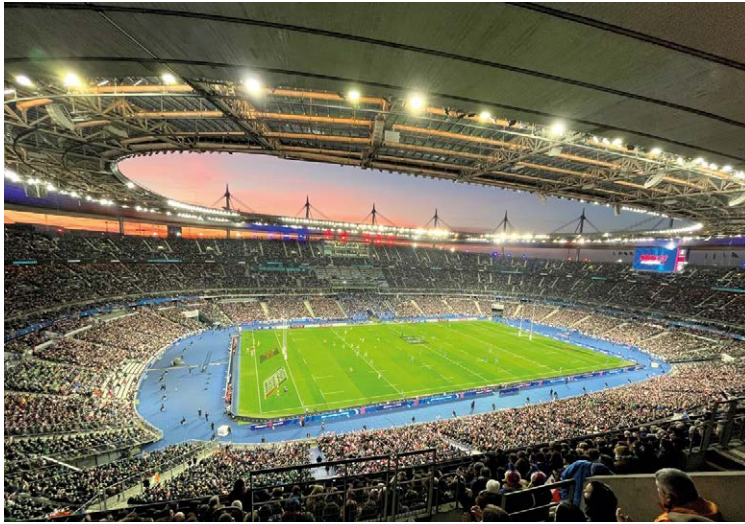

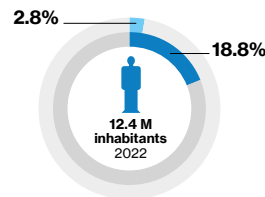

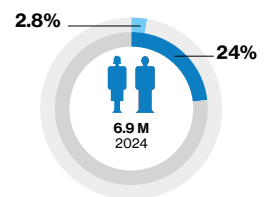


Paris Region vs. Metropolitan France & EU27

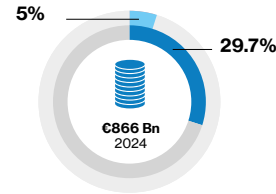

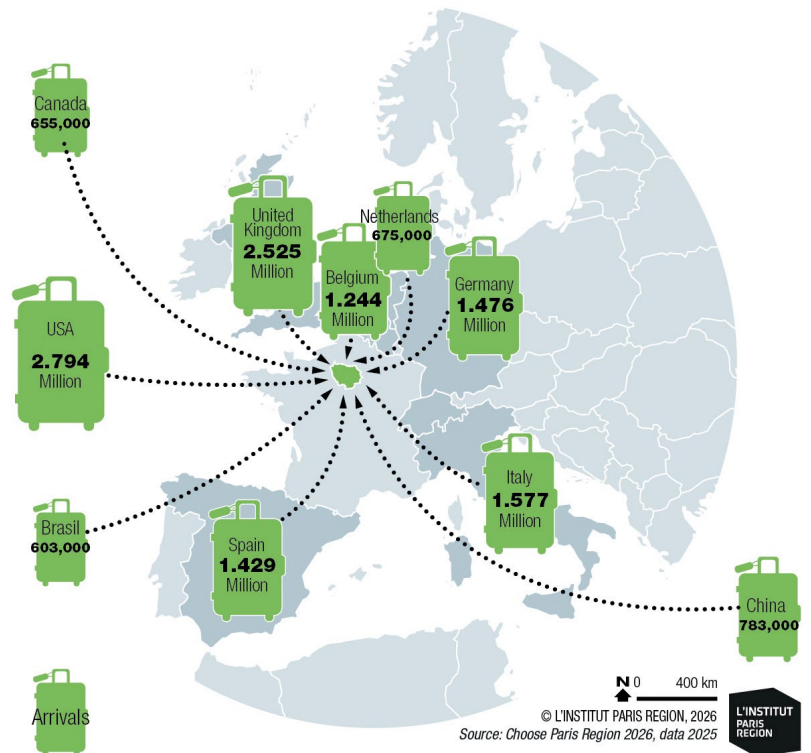

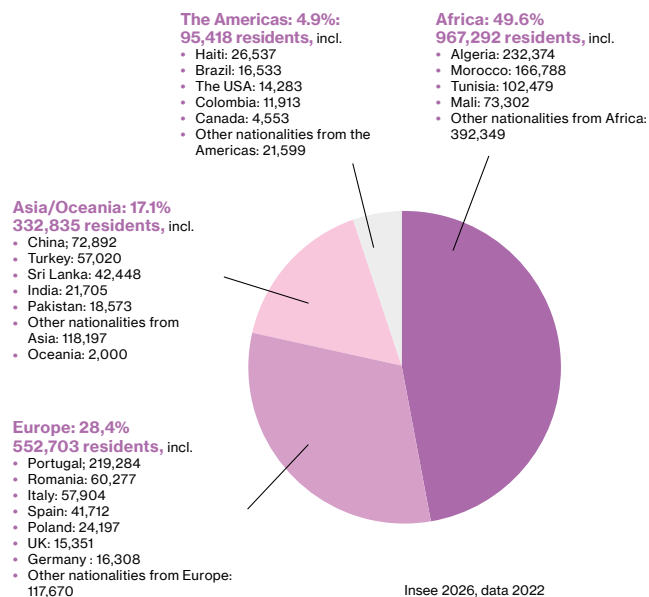

University degrees:

- Licence (L1-L3): Undergraduate degree, 3 years (6 semesters).
- Master (M1-M2): Graduate degree, 2 years (total 5 years). Can be research-oriented (leading to a doctorate) or vocational (preparing for work).
- Doctorate: 3 years (total 8 years), postgraduate research degree.

Degrees are organized by field of study, specialization, and path.

The Engineering Degree (diplôme d'ingénieur) is nationally recognized. Engineering schools are accredited by the national institute for engineering qualifications to award this degree.

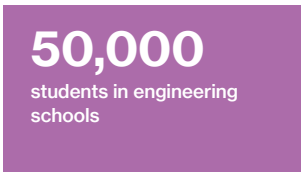

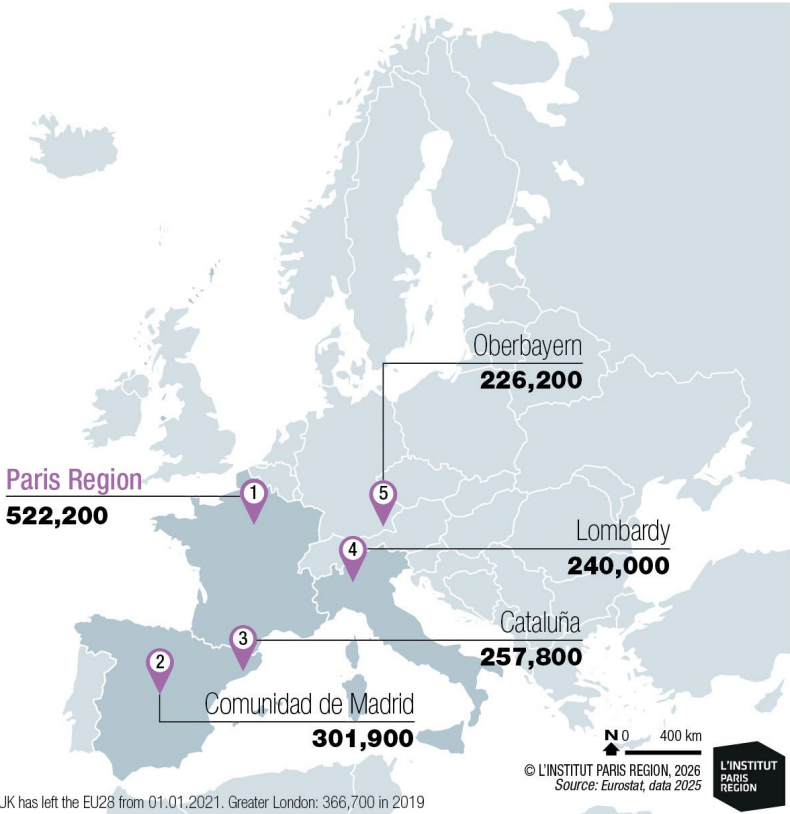

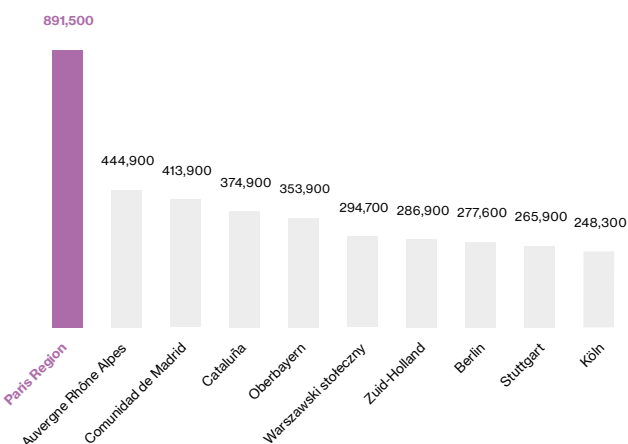

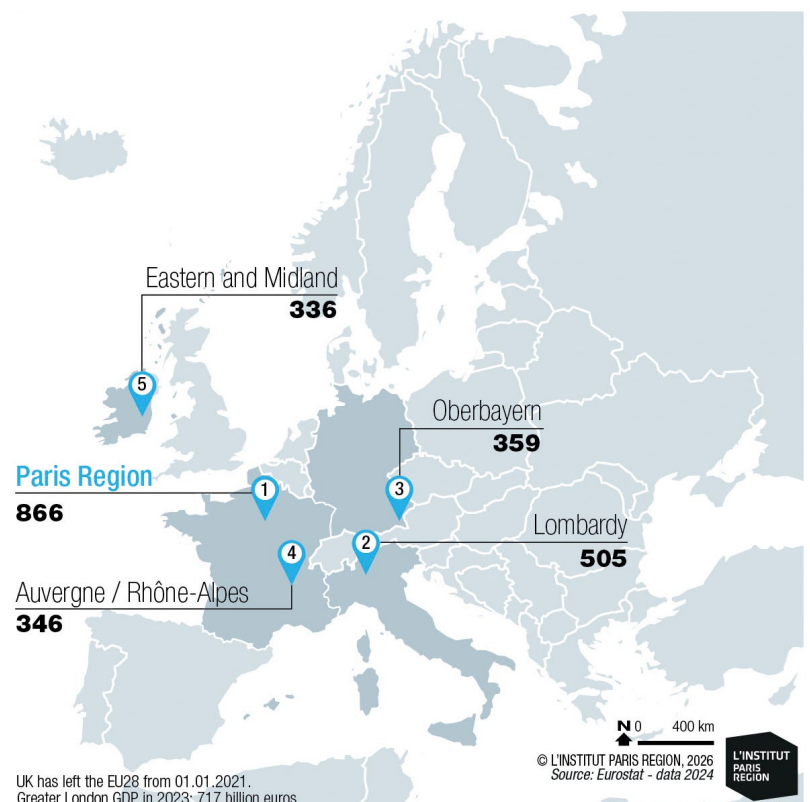

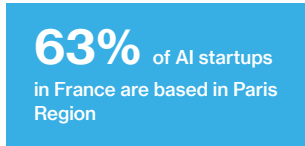

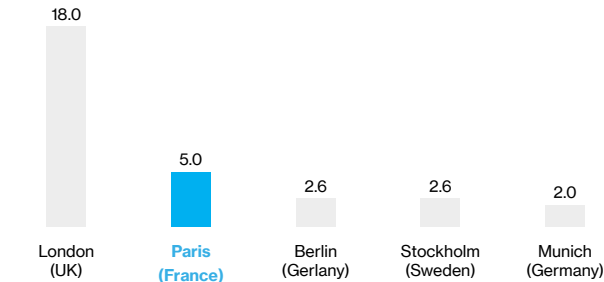

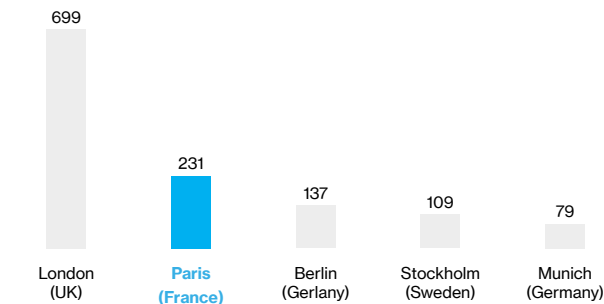

Top European Startup Hubs by VC Investment(\$B), 2025



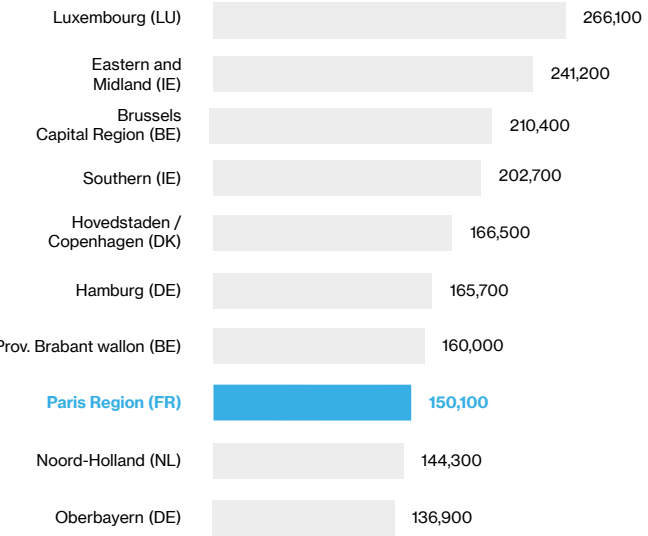

Top European Hubs by Number of Deals, 2025



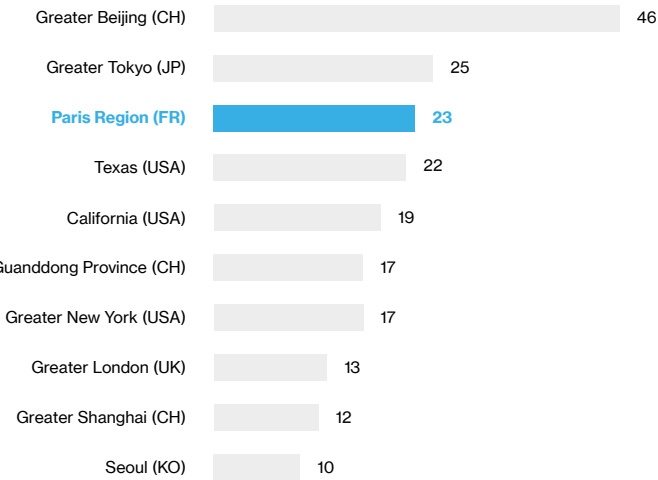

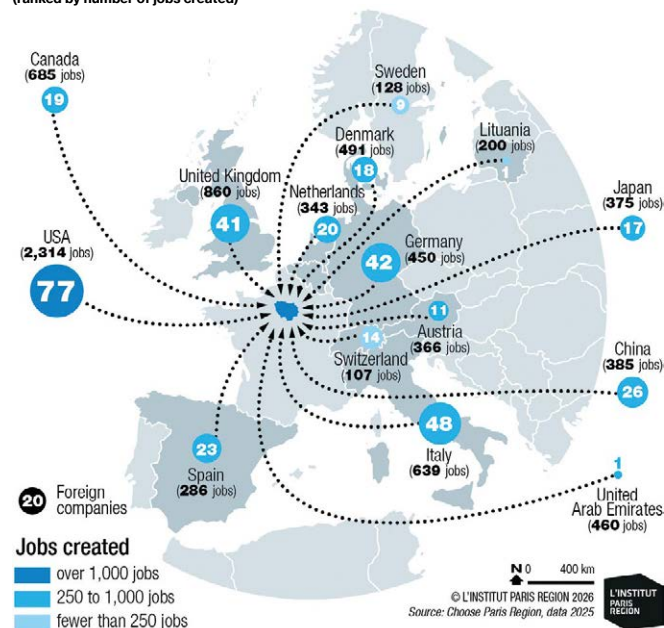

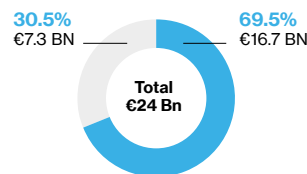

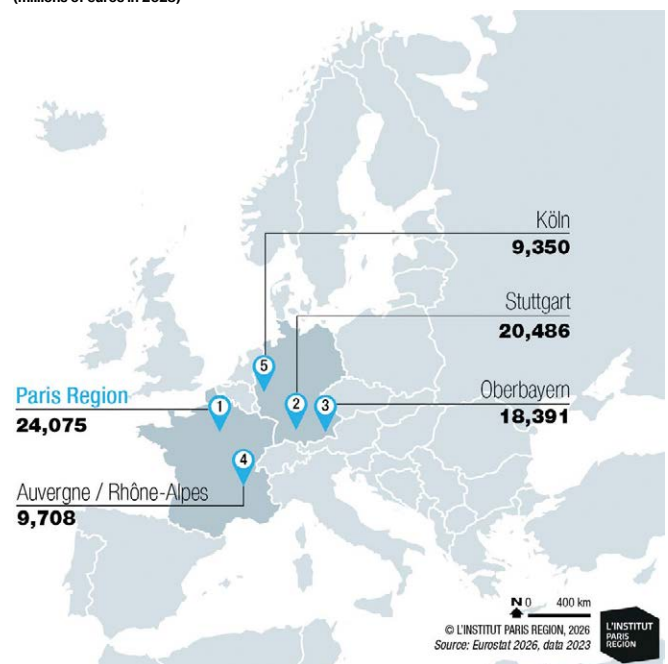

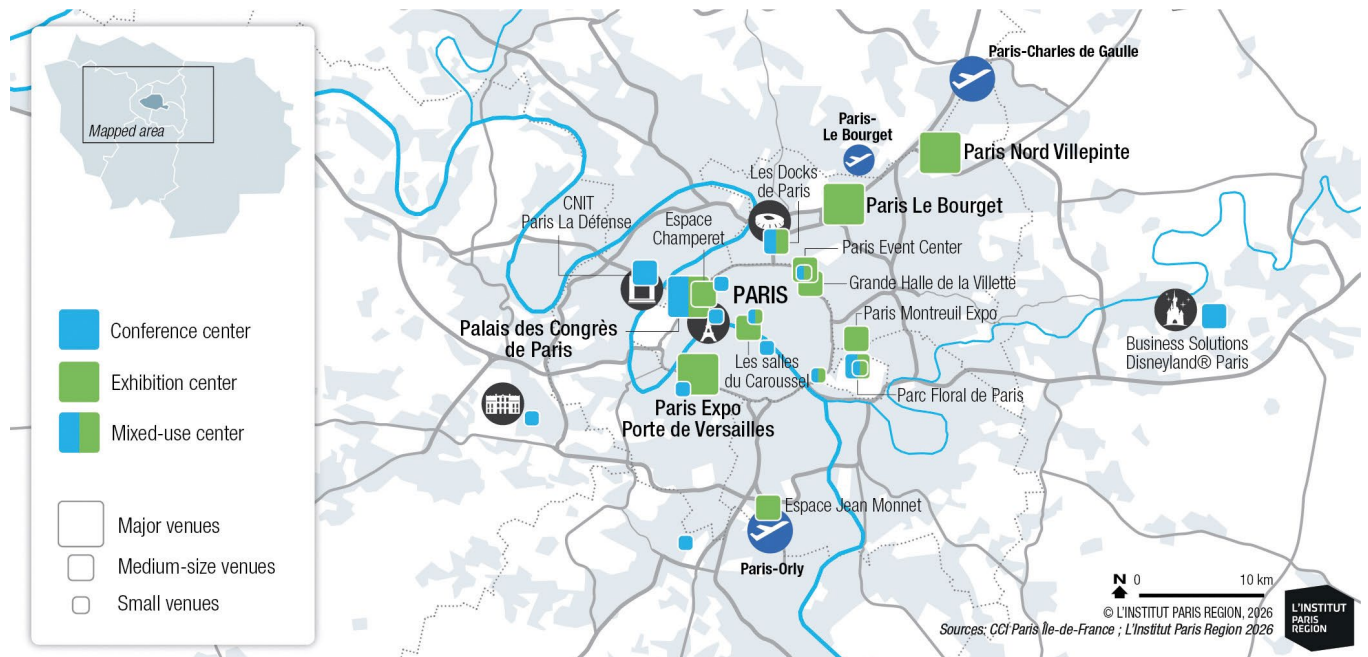

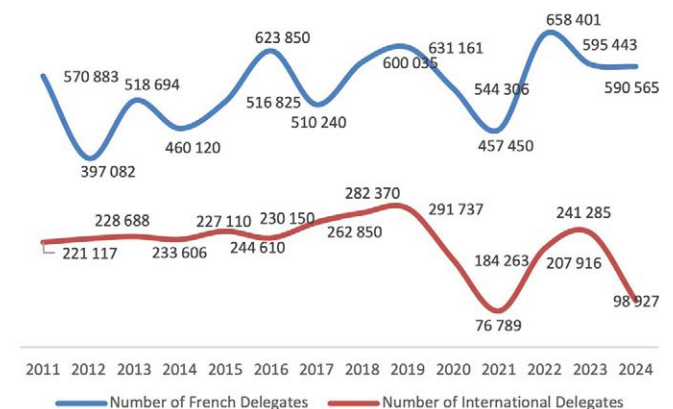

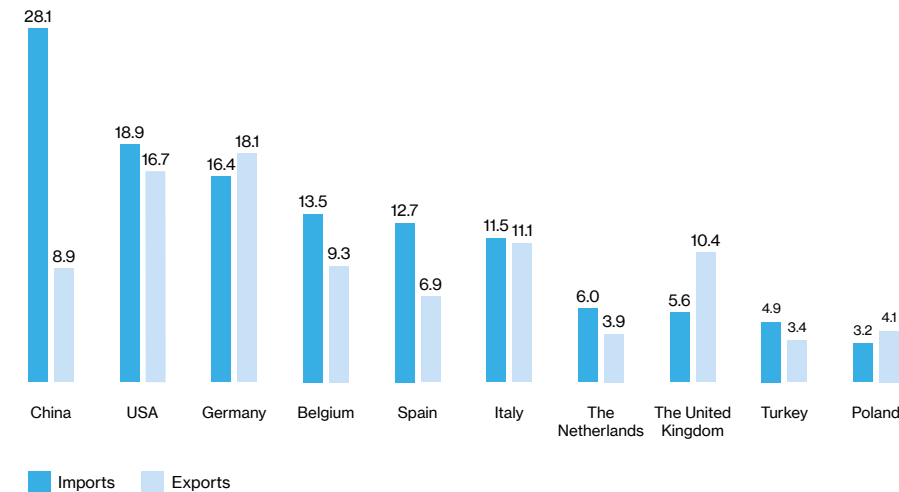

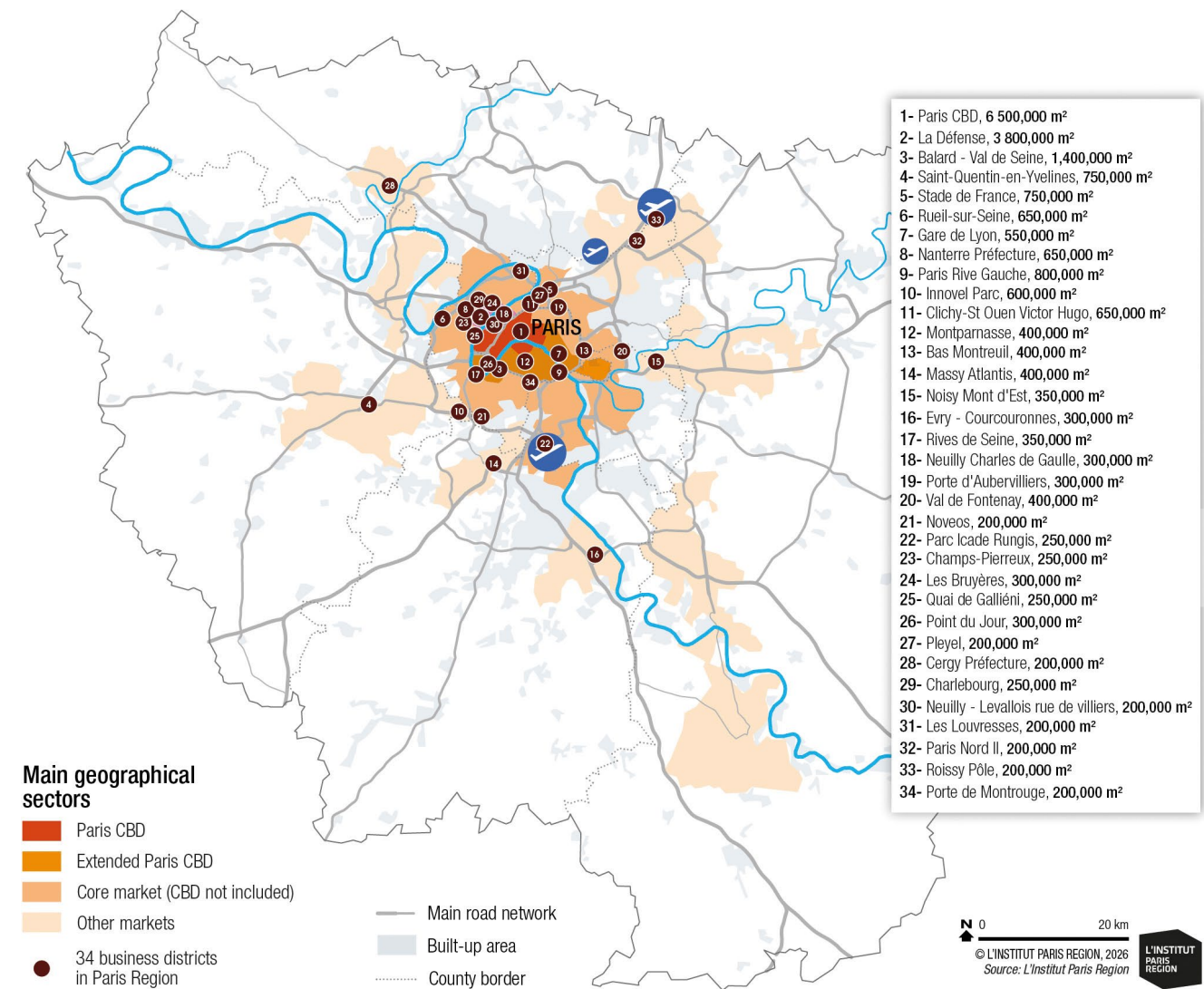

Efficient Logistics Infrastructure

Strategically located at the crossroads of two major European freight corridors, Paris Region is a leading logistics hub serving over **12 million** residents, and a catchment area of **25 million** people within **200 km**. Driven by the growth of e-commerce and increasing demand for last-mile delivery, the region fosters logistics innovation and attracts major international players. Around **90%** of freight is transported by road, **6%** by inland waterways, and **4%** by rail.

Air, Road, Waterway and Railway Logistics

Paris Region annually produces **208 million** tons of goods, primarily transported by road (**89%**), followed by river (**6%**), and rail (**5%**). This dynamic region handles both domestic and international trade, receiving imported consumer goods through two major corridors: a road-only route via the Port of Antwerp and a multimodal route through the Port of Le Havre. 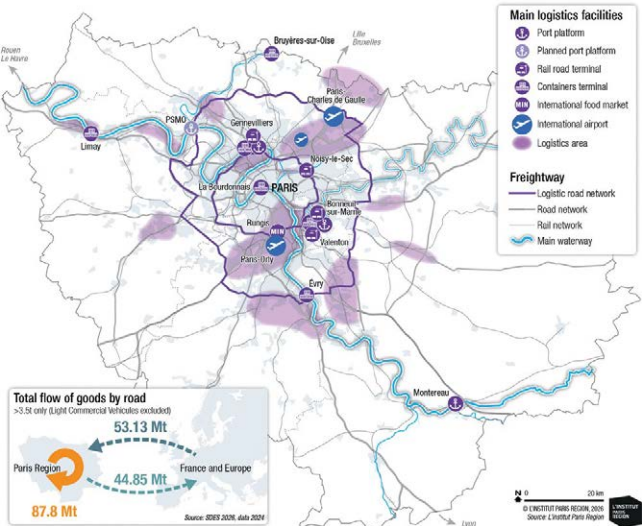

Optimizing Freight Transport

Freight transport is optimized through a multimodal supply chain system. HAROPA PORT, the Seine Axis's river-sea port complex linking Le Havre, Rouen, Paris, is Northern Europe's fourth-largest port and the main maritime gateway to Paris Region. It connects over **660** ports worldwide and supports an integrated, multimodal, and low-carbon logistics network. With **2.5 million m²** of warehouses, it handles **more than 100 million** tonnes of traffic annually, including **around 20 million** tonnes of goods for the Paris market, reducing road congestion by removing more than one million trucks from the roads.

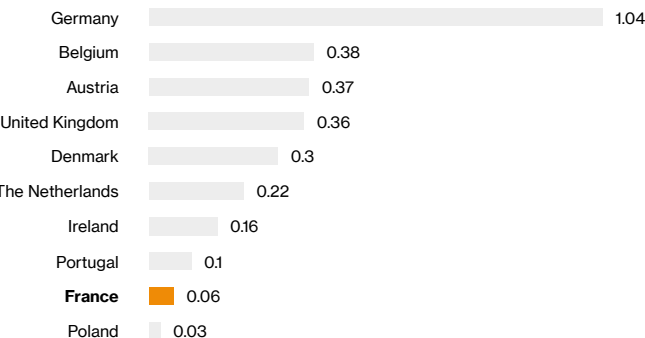

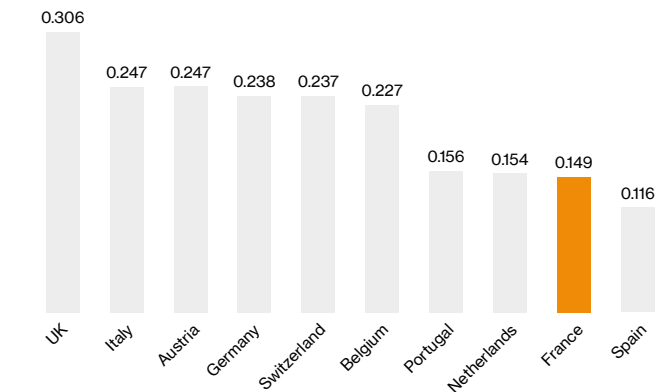
France Offers Very Competitive Telecom and Energy Costs
