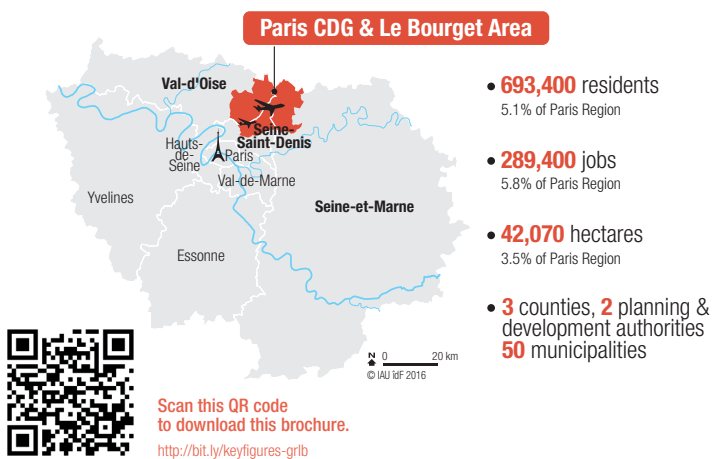


KEY FIGURES PARIS CDG & LE BOURGET AREA

Located 30 km north of the center of Paris, the Paris CDG & Le Bourget Area is the leading gateway to the French and European markets. At the heart of Europe's primary economic region, this zone has an exceptional concentration of high quality infrastructure (two international airports, 2 high-traffic highways, exhibition centers, etc.)

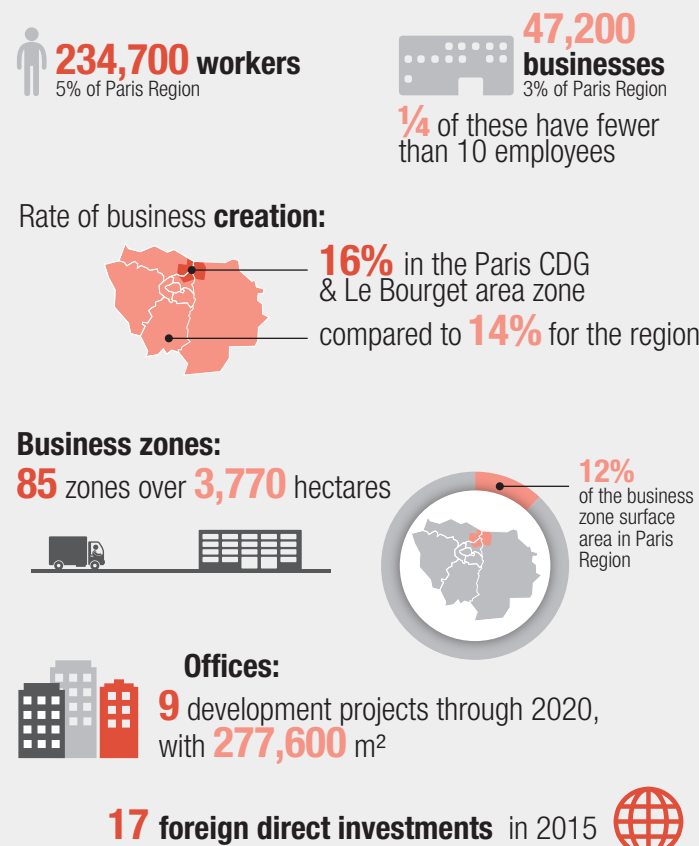
The zone's economy relies on 4 sectors of excellence: airport services, tourism and professional events, transport and logistics, and international trade. The zone has the benefit of several international business leaders and a dense network of SMEs.

Equally a residential zone, the Paris CDG & Le Bourget Area has an excellent supply of talent in its young and growing population. In this area known for new initiatives and business experimentation, over the next 15 years more than 25 major development projects will break ground, generating tens of thousands of new jobs, and more than 15 billion euros of investments.

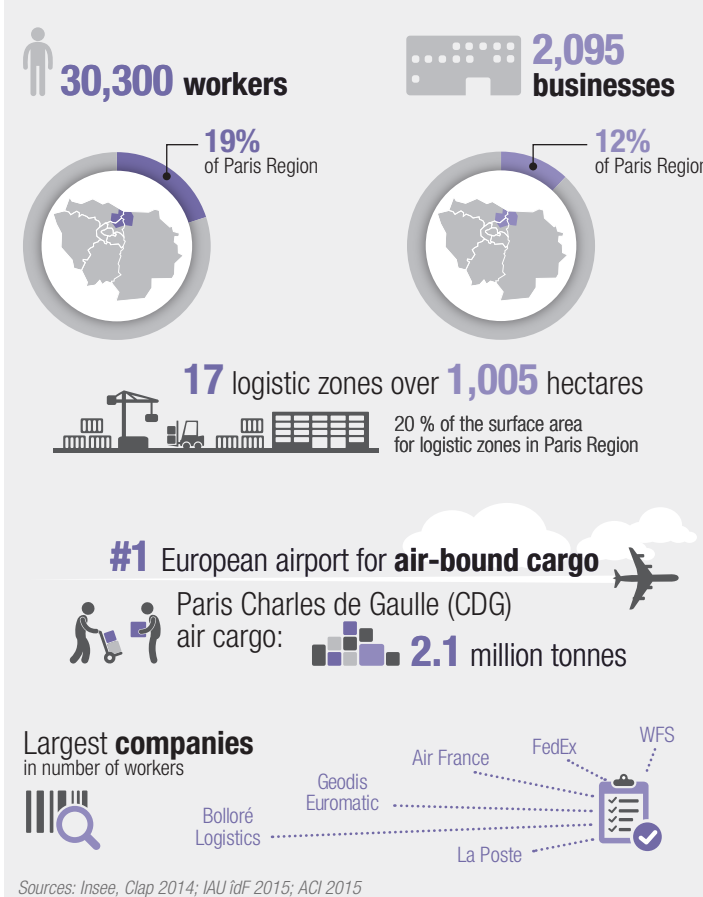

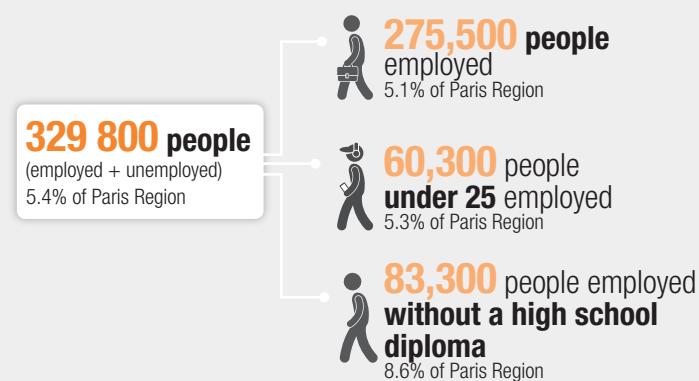

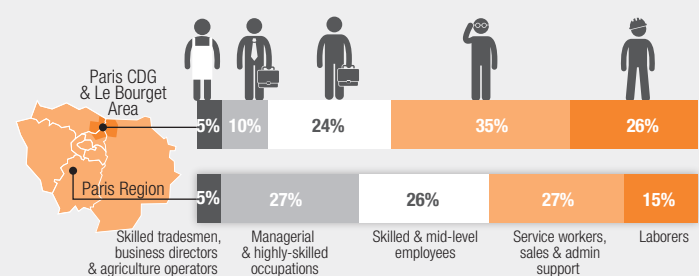

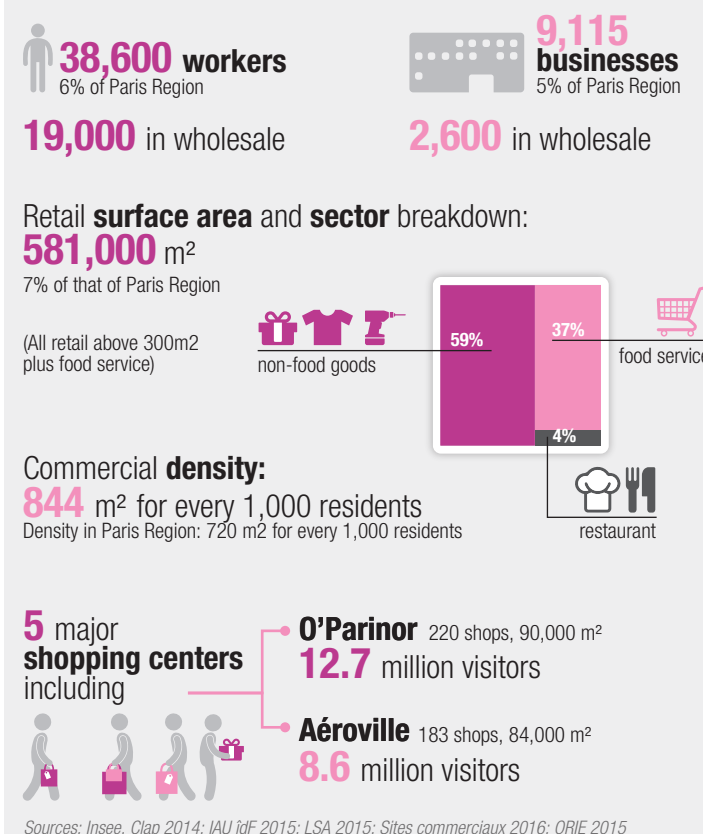


Distribution of the workforce by INSEE category of work
