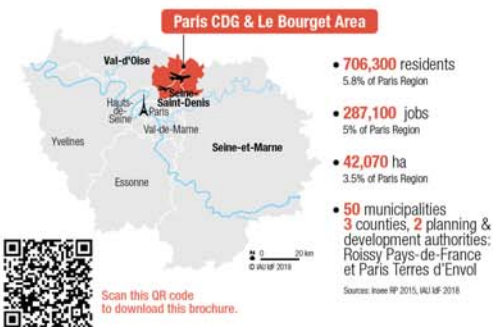
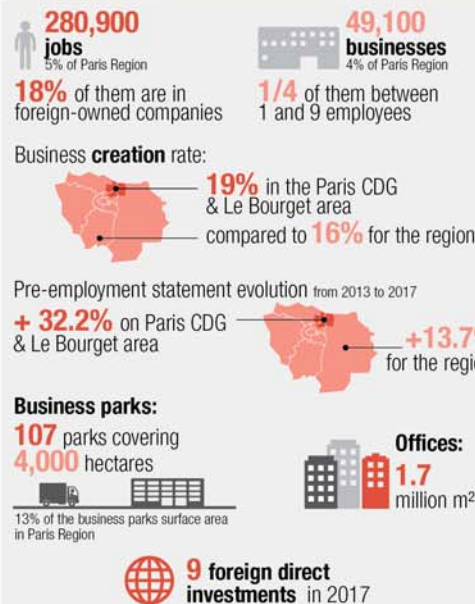

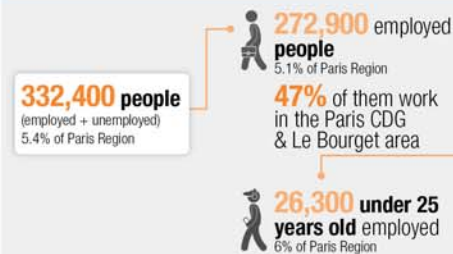

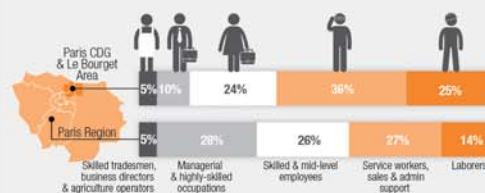

Distribution of the workforce by major occupations



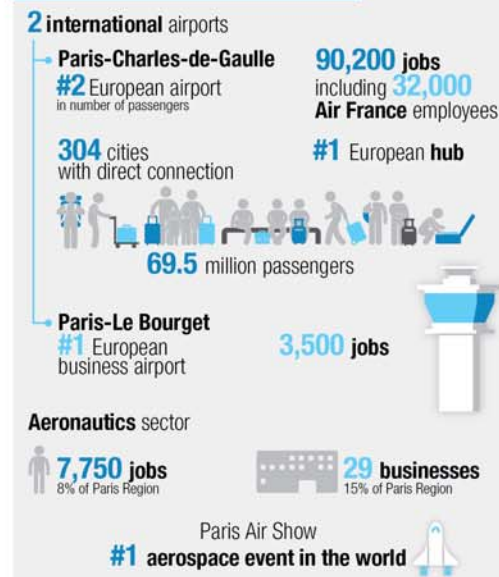
