

# Perimeter

# Diagnostic: Study definition



- Metropolitan axis (E411)

- Main transport infrastructure (roads and viaducts)
- Unsecured situation for pedestrians and cyclists
- No public place/no center
- Parks/rivers disconnected from each other
- Quasi monofunctional area (office buildings)


## Increase life quality and living together



- Close to the border between the Brussels region and the Flemish region






