

THE OCCURRENCE OF NOCTURNAL FEARS IN TRANSPORTATION IN THE PARIS REGION

Methodology

The survey "Feeling of insecurity on public transportation in the Paris region" takes an interest in the respondents' latest experience of fear. Where, when, how and with what intensity were they afraid? It is therefore possible to map the fears according to the time of day.

This map provides information on the stations and stops (RER, train and metro) where the occurrence of fear is notable from the viewpoint of the time of day. Only the sites on which at least 10 respondents replied that they were afraid were selected.

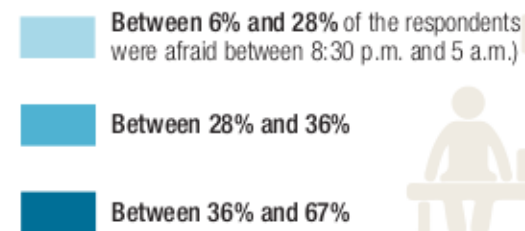
Out of 929 stations and stops in the Paris region, 346 sites were identified as anxiety-provoking by at least 10 respondents:

- 125 present a lesser proportion of nocturnal fear;
- inversely, 110 stand out by a greater proportion;
- 111 sites are situated in the average (about one respondent out of three is afraid in the evening or at night).
